October 12th Proclaimed Captain Joe Albanese Day in City of Newton
*Captain in U.S. Naval Reserves and Newton- Based Builder Returns Home
after serving in Kuwait*

(Newton, MA) October 4, 2007—Joe Albanese, Captain in the U.S. Naval Reserves and CEO of Newton- based Commodore Builders, will return home on October 5th after eight months of military service, six of which he spent serving in Kuwait. Captain Albanese provided crucial support for Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom to the U.S. and Coalition Forces. His responsibilities included the management of gear issue, procurement of construction materials, equipment and tactical vehicles, technical oversight of quality and safety programs, and the facilitation of engineering support projects.

Captain Albanese will be presented with a Proclamation by Newton Mayor David B. Cohen, officially declaring October 12th as “Captain Joe Albanese Day” in the City of Newton. Mayor Cohen is scheduled to attend the private homecoming reception being held at Commodore Builders’ new location (80 Bridge Street, Newton, Mass.), on Friday October 12th at 6:00 p.m.

“Captain Albanese is a man of incredible character, whose leadership plays a pivotal role in the lives of his troops abroad and his employees at Commodore Builders,” said Mayor Cohen.
