Dan Babine Joins Commodore as the Firm's Newest Project Executive

NEWTON, Mass. Dan took the traditional route to the top of his field – beginning at Macomber as a field engineer and continuing on as an assistant super, superintendent, project manager and ultimately the Executive at Macomber, in charge of the Housing sector.

According to Babine, "Macomber wasn't initially involved in this sector, but I had a special interest that comes from the sense of community I've always had. Succeeding in this sector was a good way to give back – and be profitable at the same time." The sector flourished under Babine's supervision, building over 3500 units of new and rehabbed housing.

During the first half of the 1990s at Macomber, Dan worked on a series of projects for State Street Bank, including a 23-floor renovation at 225 Franklin Street, as well as projects at International Place and exterior envelop and interior fit outs at State Street South, in Quincy.

In 2004, Dan established his own firm, Legacy Builders. The firm focused on filling a void by building smaller HUD-funded, low income housing projects. Over the last 7 years, Dan has worked with many of the most prominent non-profit advocates in the city of Boston.
